The UFA status allows for the contracts to be aligned related to start and end dates. This will begin with this year's contract.  Shannon indicated that one on one meetings will be scheduled to go through each contract.  Sasha asked about current contract. Connie indicated that the current contracts will continue and the new contracts will be adjusted to bring them in alignment with a single start and end date.
