Veterans Race Equity subcommittee updates	Joanna gave an update on the Veterans Race Equity subcommittee has been expanded to include Maricopa County and Pima County. Anyone who has interest, contact Joanna. The group is trying to align with the VA's national effort around addressing equity with veterans and housing. VA medical centers have been given the <u>data toolkit</u> and tasked with coming up with solutions and action steps. Solari also developed a <u>Race Equity Toolkit</u> now available on the HMIS website- this is program-level only, but it can be compared to the dashboard data.		
SSVF program updates	There is a national NOFO for SSVF to provide funding for things like housing navigation support, landlord incentives, tenant move-in support, expanding the eligibility to raise the income threshold to 80% AMI, etc.		
38k Homes Initiative Discussion	The nations VA has a target of housing 38,000 veterans, which locally will be a 5% increase over last year's numbers.		
Stand Down/Coordinated Entry Update	The most recent StandDown was in Flagstaff in May and 117 people showed up, 30 of which were homeless veterans; there are several planned for the coming months. NAVAHCS was about almost 30% of the 283 goal in the first quarter.		
Agency Updates	US Vets- Fort Whipple is still on track to house 105-125 low income housing units for veteran seniors and the disabled; ground breaking is set for early next year and renovations will take a couple of years. A grant has been submitted for an outreach specialist.		
	AHC- the AZ legislative session ended last week and an additional \$60 million will be added to the Housing Trust Fund, which was originally capped at \$2.5 million at the end of the last recession. Efforts are underway to convince the governor to double it with stimulus funds since affordable housing is such a need right now. The pilot program for veterans needing a higher level of care will be starting soon, starting with 15 veterans. BeConnected will be the referral for assignment of a navigator to assist in the placement.  ADJOURN
