	The purpose of our workgroup is to focus community planning, data analysis, strengthening stakeholder partnerships, and policy/project development. The BOS Veteran's Workgroup is dedicated to coordinating statewide efforts to enhance veteran housing resources and to assist veteran provider agencies in networking all available veteran programs and Services.

38k initiative	Joseph presented to the group the VA's 38k initiative
Arizona Pet Project	This project based in Maricopa County but is available statewide- they received funds from AZDV to provide funding for veterans with barriers to housing due to having pets; funding can be used for boarding, deposits, food, veterinary care. The program is not receiving as many referrals as anticipated, so the word still needs to be disseminated.
SSVF updates – recent NOFO awards	NCHP: for the Yuma County, Pinal County, and Tempe offices were awarded funding for a housing navigator to work with the HUD Vash program, allowing them to enroll veterans in the area that are 80% AMI instead of the usual 50%. Another area the NOFO can potentially cover is SSVF landlord incentives including double deposits and 2 months up-front rent, and another pocket of money for general housing (furniture, computers, etc.).
Race Equity Update	 This work group has been expanded to include the other two CoCs for statewide collaboration, and additional stakeholders have been added. Areas to work on are: Digging into the data, since it's available from HUD in a region-wide format and not by county, so it's not as useful as it could be. A data toolkit was developed to assist veteran service organizations to guide them on how to look at data so it's useful- this will be sent out to the CoCs for dissemination. Researching interventions for veterans who are under-represented (i.e. providing a targeted housing placement) Identifying best practices and change-ideas to support the national VA effort as the local VAs look at the data to try to create action ideas.
