

Arizona Balance of State Continuum of Care Homelessness Entry Points

Access points are listed by county to be entered into the Balance of State HMIS system to access homeless assistance. To access HUD COC Housing assistance programs individuals/families will meet the HUD criteria for Chronically Homeless/Literally Homeless as defined by HUD.

Each county may offer a different array of services depending upon the community agencies and as funds are available.

The services may be motel vouchers, rent, utilities and utility deposits for homeless prevention, food bank, food referral services, emergency shelter, temporary shelter, move-in assistance, rent/mortgage assistance, clothing, case management for men/women and families, shelter beds for victims of domestic violence, utility discount programs with APS, SW Gas and Lifeline, energy assistance, weatherization, senior programs, behavioral health services for counseling, drug & alcohol programs, services for persons with diagnoses of substance use disorders, serious mental illness, general mental health, employment services (check with AHCCCS agency or Veterans Administration for the specific services they provide), residential rehabilitation, etc.

Solari has a Coordinated Entry line that can be accessed by calling 2-1-1. The 2-1-1 number is also available to provide resources in the various Balance of State counties.
