### **Updates**

2020 HUD data standards became effective October 1, 2019, but due to software issues wasn't rolledout until October 29, 2019. Glorianna gave an overview of the changes.

CRN will be sending out the annual user survey later in November, with completion requested by mid-December. Visibility issues with DES-funded programs have been resolved. Annual refresher training will be streamlined, and the majority would like to have a "highlights" training now, with a more complete all-inclusive training roughly mid-March, 2020.

Ryan V. gave an update from a recent meeting with WellSky, which is the HMIS software vendor. ServicePoint will slowly be phased out with incremental updates to components (e.g. the website) starting in December.

### **Document Review/Updating**

The HMIS Policy and Procedures Manual was partially reviewed by the group and several updates were incorporated. The remainder of the HMIS Policy and Procedures Manual, the HMIS Partnership Agreement, the HMIS Code of Ethics document, plus other documents will be updated at the next meeting, scheduled for December 4, 2019.
