Agency Updates	CCCS- Family shelter in Flagstaff is currently only housing one family with the hopes of getting another of the two unused units up and running; new staff have been hired in Page at the new Day Center; in Bullhead City, the shelter will hopefully reopen in the coming months CAHRA- interviewing for a full-time position Solari- changed names, formerly Crisis Response Network; Glori Vercruyssen is leaving the company and the position is posted OCCAC- the LCEH in Apache and Navajo Counties are developing in conjunction with each other. Gila County- the warming center is continuing to serve evening meals between 5:00p-6:30p; starting a life-skills program ADOH- the Housing Forum will take place August 18-21st in Tucson; the 2020 COC Agreements from HUD have been received; the 2021 NOFA has not yet been announced by HUD; the UFA application determination is still pending; the LCEH lead agencies are being asked to designate representatives to the various committees (Veterans, HMIS, CE) in order to establish consistency in attendance and LCEH representation.
