Stand Down/Coordinated Entry Update	➤ Joanna will follow up with Stand Downs and HMIS data entry. The AHC has been working with Solari and Be Connected to capture the data at Stand Downs in order to enter veterans' information who attend Stand Downs and are homeless into HMIS		
ADOH Update	<ul> <li>The AZ Housing Forum was held last week in Tucson</li> <li>The HUD NOFA is out and the application will be completed as soon as possible</li> <li>Currently hiring for the COC Coordinator position</li> </ul>		
Agency Updates	<ul> <li>Currently hiring for the COC Coordinator position</li> <li>AHC: The AHC Conference is coming up in October on the 26th and 27th and the next legislative session will be soon; Stand Downs are proceeding at a fast pace with veterant self-identifying as homeless being entered into HMIS</li> <li>HOHP: Just about ready to open a transitional center in Pinal County; the first floor is almost completed and up to 10 homeless veterans will be sheltered (the second floor will have to wait since the price of lumber has gone up)</li> <li>US Vets: A Stand Down will take place September 17 and 18; there are about 13 transitional beds open but there has been an increase in phone calls so beds are filling quickly; 7 TII placements available, and one PSH unit available.</li> <li>JAVC: GPD program opened in February, with 15 beds still available, with substance abuse and/or service-intensive needs being the focus.</li> <li>AZDVS: The two veterans homes will be opening in September (Flagstaff and Yuma); the deadline for MFRF is being extended (MFRF can be used with other housing programs such as VASH)- there just has to be a provable hardship</li> </ul>		
	VA: Vaccinations are being offered to veterans and their families and caregivers; in coordination with US Vets developing a Use Lease program with 103 PSH units available.
