- The Workgroup will work to develop a charter. Examples from North Carolina, Virginia, Utah and TPCH were provided. It was agreed that work on a charter begins with a mission.

- The Charter needs to explain the Balance of State structure, identify different planning groups and describe what authority each group will have
- Karia mentioned that the CoC renewal tier 2 project results should be announced in May
- The Workgroup liked the charter example provided from the CoC in Virginia, felt that is was easy to understand as well as descriptive enough for our needs
- When the charter is drafted, it will be brought to the larger group for feedback at the Balance of State annual meeting in the fall
- ADOH is working on visiting areas with low/no BOS participation and presenting on the Continuum to try and encourage/foster development of a local Continuum
- Karia is working on a chart that lists all scheduled local Continuum meetings in the BOS region and it was mentioned that attending other meetings is encouraged
- As the charter is developed, each piece will be addressed at subsequent meetings
- Additional announcements
 - Dave announced that an SHP client has made the successful transition to Section 8, then on to Section 8 homeownership
 - Karia announced that ADOH is currently compiling Point In Time count data and over
 1000 interviews were completed
 - Barbara announced that Cochise County has re-established a Continuum meeting and had 21 attendees at the first meeting
