RE: HOME-ARP Allocation Plan Substantial Amendment February 2025

The State of Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH) is proposing to amend the HUD-approved HOME-ARP Allocation Plan to make changes in the method of distributing funds. The allocation plan is an amendment to the State's PY2021 HUD Annual Allocation Plan. The proposed amendment relates to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) HOME Investment Partnerships Program - American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) funding. The intended use of the funding is to assist individuals or households who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, and other vulnerable populations.

The amendment changes will allow the ADOH to redistribute the allocation of funds to meet the housing, shelter, and service needs of eligible populations while maintaining compliance with federal regulations and the eligibility requirements for HOME-ARP assistance. The Department has a remaining balance of **\$2,611,250.90 in HOME-ARP funds available to allocate.**

Public Comments

The ADOH encourages residents, subrecipients and grantees, public agencies and other interested parties to review the draft Plan and submit comments. **The thirty (30) day public comment period begins February 14, 2025, and ends on March 17, 2025.** During the public comment period, comments and questions may be submitted to publiccomment@azhousing.gov.
