RE: Notice of Public Hearing for 2025-2026 Weatherization Assistance Program Plan (WAP Plan), State of Arizona HUD Citizen Participation Plan, 5-year (PY2025-PY2029) 5-yr HUD Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan), PY2025 HUD Annual Action Plan (Action Plan), and substantial amendment to the Recovery Housing Program Plan (RHP Plan)

The Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH) will hold a public hearing and public comment period to receive input on the 2025-2026 Weatherization Assistance Program Plan (WAP Plan), State of Arizona HUD Citizen Participation Plan, 5-year (PY2025-PY2029) 5-yr HUD Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan), PY2025 HUD Annual Action Plan (Action Plan), and substantial amendment to the Recovery Housing Program Plan (RHP Plan).

The WAP Plan establishes goals, objectives, priorities, activities, outcomes, and the method of distribution for approximately \$2.4 million in US Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance funds.

The Citizen Participation Plan describes policies and procedures for public involvement in the Consolidated Plan, Action Plan, and RHP Plan.

The Consolidated Plan describes priority needs and five-year goals and objectives for approximately \$109.2 million of US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Planning and Development program funding.

The PY2025 Action Plan describes the methods of distribution for and planned uses of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), National Housing Trust Fund (NHTF), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) programs administered by the ADOH, and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program administered by the Arizona Department of Economic Security. These HUD funds are used for activities benefitting low-income and special needs populations throughout Arizona. The Action Plan covers the period beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026 for approximately \$21.85 million in funding.

The substantial amendment to the RHP Plan describes the methods of distribution for and eligible uses of approximately \$2 million of FFY2024 and FFY2025 Recovery Housing Program funding from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development. The RHP Plan also describes eligible subrecipients, criteria for evaluation of applications and applicants, and anticipated outcomes.

Public Hearing. The public hearing will begin at 11:00 am on Wednesday, April 9, 2025. You may attend virtually or in person.
