Storacle Point Apartments

Storacle Point Apartments, is being recognized for bringing together resources to redevelop infill parcels in the City of Tucson with the unique combination of accessible single family and multi-family supportive housing, for very low income households as a part of a community revitalization project.

The project represents the new construction of 66 affordable housing units consisting of 44 one-bedroom, 12 three-bedroom and 10 four-bedroom units.

The units are constructed on four infill scattered sites in the City of Tucson.



The project's central location was designed to aid in the redevelopment of the City of Tucson's Oracle Neighborhood Revitalization area to eliminate areas of blight and converting them to affordable housing.

Storacle Point Apartments serves families and low-income persons in need of supportive services; Households with Children; and includes City of Tucson for Project Based Vouchers to serve Chronically Homeless Persons with a preference for Veterans.

Storacle Point Apartments provides a unique housing opportunity by bringing single family homes and brand new apartment complexes in small scale, given the scattered site design, and onsite management presence helping to stabilize the neighborhoods.
