Everyone was welcomed, and the meeting started at 9:09 a.m. Attendees introduced themselves.

Local Updates:

Cristina gave an update on training that was provided through AzCH, ADOH, and CRN for the southern RBHA in Sierra Vista, Yuma, and Casa Grande; AzCH will be going live in HMIS on April 1, 2019. These participating RBHAs may serve as assessment sites/access points at clinics for people who are or need to be enrolled, and who are RBHA-eligible and homeless; the clinics will be able to do a VI-SPDAT. Those people experiencing homelessness will populate onto the BNL.

Ross gave an update that everyone on their list who qualify for RRH has been contacted.

By-Name List Updates:

ROI forms are now showing up on the BNL, but this field still needs to be cleaned up. People's names in HMIS without ROIs will remain visible, to facilitate contacting them to obtain an updated ROI, but starting in May their names will be de-identified.

The referral process isn't consistent or updated in HMIS in a timely manner, which is exacerbated by inconsistent meeting attendance. Updating/streamlining this process will be ongoing.

Review HUD Coordinated Entry and Data Guide:

The group continued to review the compilation/summary Candee put together to draft a CE guide based on HUD's version as a template; the Assessment section was finished and numbers 55 through 67 were reviewed in the Prioritization section.

Action Item: David will add universities to the list of partners to bring in when discussing how aging could affect homelessness (i.e. a person who develops dementia and can no longer keep track of bills and becomes homeless because of it).

Action Item: David will research to whom people appeal to if they are claiming discrimination. David will also check with DES regarding ESGs-funded programs, what the appeal process is.

Action Item: Glorianna will follow-up with Ty regarding the progress on developing protocols for data sharing.

Action Item: David will bring the privacy policy for the next CE meeting, Glorianna will bring HMIS Informed Consent and ROI forms, and everyone should bring whatever privacy document(s) being used as part of each program's intake packet, for comparison to see if everyone is using the same set of forms.

Action Item: Everyone needs to go through their portion of the BNL and try to contact people to obtain ROIs for those who do not currently have one.
