THE HEARTH ACT, ENACTED INTO LAW ON MAY 20, 2009, REQUIRES THAT ALL COMMUNITIES HAVE AN HMIS WITH THE CAPACITY TO COLLECT UNDUPLICATED COUNTS OF INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS. THROUGH THEIR HMIS, A COMMUNITY SHOULD BE ABLE TO COLLECT INFORMATION FROM PROJECTS SERVING HOMELESS FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS TO USE AS PART OF THEIR NEEDS ANALYSES AND TO ESTABLISH FUNDING PRIORITIES. THE ACT ALSO CODIFIES INTO LAW CERTAIN DATA COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS INTEGRAL TO HMIS. WITH ENACTMENT OF THE HEARTH ACT, HMIS PARTICIPATION BECAME A STATUTORY REQUIREMENT FOR RECIPIENTS AND SUBRECIPIENTS OF COC PROGRAM AND EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANTS (ESG) FUNDS.

2014 HUD DATA STANDARDS

- Every 3 years HUD releases new updates
- 2017 will be next update
- We are still working on 2014 Standards
- Now on version 5.1
- HUD has some more changes beginning October 1
- All CURRENT clients will need to be updated
 - If exited BEFORE October 1, they do NOT have to be updated unless they return.
- There will be new Assessments coming

UDE CHANGES

- GENDER: "Other" replace with "Doesn't identify as male, female, or transgender"
- DISABLING CONDITION: Now required for ALL Clients
- PRIOR LIVING SITUATION 3.917 A & B: Big changes. Used to determine Chronic Homelessness. More information coming.

PROGRAM SPECIFIC CHANGES

- Moderate changes for:
 - PATH
 - SSVF
- **Indian Health Insurance** added to picklist
- **Residential Move in Date** required for RRH projects ONLY

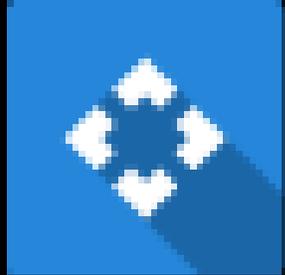

Qlik Sense Desktop

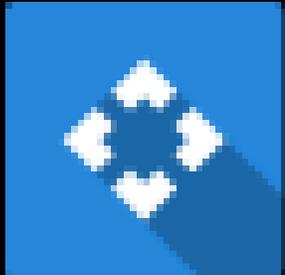


- Very FAST – will not have to Schedule reports to run
