Membership:

Some LCEH's are having trouble recruiting members and having consistent attendance.

Action Item: Ryan will develop a one-page synopsis of what the LCEH's do that can be handed out as a recruitment tool.

Eric Marcus is replacing Barbara Mikkelsen as the northern RBHA representative, and Silvia Chavez will be filling the newly added Department of Education board member position.

Action Item: Ryan will verify with Betsy if she will be the DV representative or if someone else from DES will fill that role.

No member positions are currently up for renewal or recruitment, except Carole's position in 2020.

Review PIT survey for 2020:

A draft version of next year's PIT survey was handed out and briefly discussed.

Strategic Action Planning:

The Strategic Action Plan, developed at the 2019 retreat was handed out.

Performance Measure #1

A baseline for the length of time people remain homeless needs to be established so subsequent data can show if time homeless is being reduced by 10% (Performance Measure #1). CRN is currently developing a performance metrics dashboard to show baselines; this will be presented at the sub-recipient meeting in December.

Case conferencing notes (i.e. case histories) are entered on the BNL for each person.

Action Item: HMIS folks will be invited to the next meeting and can bring up on screen a BNL to discuss a random sampling of notes to see if there are trends.

Performance Measure #2

CRN is developing a procedure to pull a couple system performance measures by agency/program and county type to see reasons and patterns for returning to homelessness. A small review subcommittee will be established to refine this to bring for discussion at the subrecipient meeting scheduled for December 17, 2019. The GAB will also review this procedure. The Action Item will be extended to March of 2020.

Performance Measure #3

Diversion training is continuing county by county and should meet the April 2020 goal; after preliminary training is completed, standards and protocols for training can be finalized and possibly a webinar-type style can be available. Diversion data standards from HUD will be rolled out in April 2020 along with CE data standards, so policies and procedures will need to be developed prior to that.

Action Item: Ryan will find out why SMI is excluded in the diversion training.

Performance Measure #4

Funding for SOAR is outcome-based, and if people submitting SOAR applications are not entering data in OAT, there is no ability to ask for funding by SAMHSA. Case managers can enter a Medicaid code (T1016 with an HK modifier) to be able to bill the time spent on these applications.

Action Item: Joy will follow-up with Adam Robson with AHCCCS to see if this is a fully active process and how much it bills per hour.
