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Everyone was welcomed, and the meeting started at 10:02 a.m. Roll-call was taken. Cristina motioned, seconded by Chanania (with no objections) to approve the minutes.

### Updates

CRN has added two new positions; an HMIS Manager position, to which Glorianna Vercruyssen was promoted, which will be in charge of the day-to-day operating support for HMIS issues, and a Homeless Initiative Administrator who will provide detailed support for the CoC's. Hillary was recently hired for the Homeless Initiative Administrator position.

Larry Singer is no longer the new director of Good Neighbor Alliance. Brad Roland is filling in as the interim Administrative Director.

### Unit Manager Demonstration

A demonstration of the new Unit Manager software that is replacing ShelterPoint will be demonstrated on March 11<sup>th</sup> from 10:00a-11:00a. Anyone interested in this should contact Ryan so he can send the invitation. April 13<sup>th</sup> will be a soft roll-out to system administrators to coordinate training, and then a few weeks after that it will be available for everyone who currently uses ShelterPoint.

### HMIS Dashboards Tracking SPM & Provider Metrics

CRN is creating two different dashboards; a System Performance Measures dashboard to track the System Performance Measures per LCEH on a quarterly basis, and a Provider Metric dashboard to track data quality based on program type. The SPM Dashboard will be provided once a quarter as a Power Point Presentation. CRN will have a completed version of this dashboard by the end of June.

CRN is working with their Business Intelligence department to solidify the coding around the metrics for the Provider Metric Dashboard. The first two calculations for the dashboard will be completed by the end of the month. CRN will complete two more calculations every two months until the dashboard is complete.

These dashboards aid in the monitoring of data quality for the NOFA and federal reports.

### **Future Committee Meetings/Schedule/Agenda Items**

There was discussion whether to move to bi-monthly or quarterly meetings.

*Action Item: Melissa will send out a poll to get participant feedback on which schedule to use in the future.*

Ryan asked the group to provide agenda item suggestions moving forward (i.e. things that need clarification or support or things on which anyone would like feedback from other users).

- For CRN to disseminate monthly “newsletters” with information, to which CRN replied that they offer monthly webinars for which the notes are posted online; frequently they have to cancel due to lack of participation.
- To have an update on data that is being reported, such as what is being tracked submission of the NOFA.
- How users are doing as a whole on data completeness, securing of ROIs, etc.
- Initiating a standard format/structure for BOS HMIS Committee meetings so that the information being discussed can help guide data discussions at the local level.

*Action Item: Ryan will work on a set of standard agenda topics for HMIS BOS Committee based on the feedback received from the committee members.*

- How to work with the PATH Grant recipients so their data quality doesn't appear poorly compiled.

*Action Item: Ryan reach out to the PATH administrator to see if there are any measures that can be put into place to improve data quality.*
