Everyone was welcomed, and the meeting started at 10:04 a.m. Roll-call was taken. Miguel motioned, seconded by Ellen (with no objections) to approve the minutes.

ShelterPoint/Unit Manager Conversion

Unit Manager is still set to replace ShelterPoint, but there is no firm date when the switch will go live.

Agency Updates

CRN now has a live person on the 211 phone line, and CRN is assisting with the COVID-19 contact tracking in conjunction with the Arizona Department of Health Services.

Catholic Charities' Bullhead City Shelter is on hold due to COVID-19 issues, but a woman's re-entry house is being established in Williams and is ready to accept clients.

WACOG has been able to house most of their clients and expend all funding.

WYGC has added three housing units.

HMIS SPM Provider/County Dashboards Update

CRN is still in the design phase of creating two dashboards; one will be for SPMs at the local level, and the other is Performance Metrics based on program type.

BOS Missing ROI Updates

ROIs are missing in PATH/AHCCCS eligible clients, mainly for those only using ShelterPoint. Glorianna showed on her screen where the easy-to-overlook ROI data entry point is located. Obtaining the ROI SHOULD be done at the time of program enrollment.

HMIS COVID-19 Risk Assessment Review and Discussion

COVID-19 data collection was initially not required in BOS. HUD hasn't yet mandated that COVID-19 data collection be conducted, but they are strongly encouraging CE prioritization policies to align with high-risk individuals. Ryan shared Maricopa County's Risk Assessment Tool and their data collection workflow. Hillary shared a link with COVID-19 HMIS Resources located on the internet at: https://www.hudexchange.info/resource/5994/covid19-hmis-setup-and-data-sharing-practices/.

Discussion centered around specifics such as would the assessment only apply to the HOH, to the entire household as a group (i.e. if anyone in the household had any listed conditions that make them vulnerable to COVID-19, the whole household would be considered high-risk), or if the assessment would need to be done for each individual IN the household. There is no timeline for rolling this out, so further discussion is required.

Ryan would like to present to the GAB the HMIS and CE Committees' recommendations for implementing (or not) a COVID-19 risk assessment tool at the next meeting on June 18th, 2020.
