Santa Cruz County- Helen is experiencing growth, transitioning of positions. Getting some help with HMIS.

NAVAHCS- Joe is new to the position- working/collaborating with agencies and the community.

Achieve- developing a website; Yumahomeless.com is the temporary website **DDD-** no updates at this time. Have resources for DDD with re-entry.
