Action: Review and approval of meeting notes from 2.10.2023	Candee Stanton (Independent Contractor)  Camie made a motion to approve. Terrance seconded. Meeting notes were approved					
<ul> <li>Discussion about additional recruitment for board members—review current applications submitted.</li> <li>Suggestion about one on one recruitment and outreach</li> </ul>	Camie indicated the discussion about membership started in December and has continued. As agreed at the last meeting one of the vacant positions will go to the ACES DV Coalition.  Camie indicated three applications were received. There was consensus to review the applications. Applicants reviewed:  • Kelly Tanner-AZYP—Youth serving agency. Non CoC funded organization. David asked if Kelly was involved in the Mohave LCEH. Nay indicated that she was involved.  • Carole Benedict-US Vets—Camie indicated that Carole has been on the Board previously and served as chair. They are CoC funded and also have other projects.					

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	<ul> <li>Clayton Abernathy — indicates that he is housing developer. He did not indicate his involvement in the AZBOSCOC geographic area. Terrance indicated that he does know Mr. Abernathy from the Ideal Institute. They build tiny homes—and use the construction as a teaching option. Terrance indicated that the Ideal Institute is partnering with them on a tiny homes project in Eloy.</li> <li>Kelly Williams—A discussion took place that there can only be one representative per agency. Nay indicated that Kelly will be filling in for her as needed</li> </ul>
	Ross indicated and there was consensus that a membership should be reserved for a representative from the tribal community. (This had been approved at the February meeting).
	Another discussion took place around whether to go from 13 to 15 members. Terrance made a motion to expand the board from 13 to 15. Maria Elena asked for clarification that 15 would include tribal representation and the DV Coalition. The motion passed unanimously.
	Terrance made a motion to approve an invitation to the three individuals who have applied Karin seconded the motion. The motion passed. Kristi abstained.
	David indicated he will follow up with AHCCCS to confirm who will be the representative from AHCCCS. He will also follow up with the ACES DV Coalition to identify a representative.
	A discussion took place about outreach to recruit a representative from tribal communities.
	Camie suggested that everyone can reach out to current individuals in tribal communities involved in the LCEHs
	Joanna indicated Lucinda Yazzie is involved with JEDI. She also indicated that she is involved with Arizona Advisory Health Care for Tribal Communities organization. There was consensus Joanna would reach out and see if there was interest in becoming involved in the GAB as a board member.
	Maria Elena indicated that since there are 22 tribes, another group which is possible is the Southwestern Women's Indigenousness Group.
	Joanna indicated there is a committee meeting tomorrow where they can discuss.
