Please review prior to the meeting so we can make efficient use of the time. September 20th (10:30p-12:30p)—Case Conferencing—For this meeting we will discuss how case conferencing operates in different LCEHs so we can add a section to the policy that is more specific about the purpose of case conferencing and suggestions about how it is facilitated. October 17th (1:00p-3:00p)—Assessment (VI-SPDAT)—For this meeting, we will have an in-depth discussion about how we want to proceed related to assessment and continued use of the VI-SPDAT. November 29th (10:00a-noon)—Review of the CE policy with information incorporated from the previous meetings. HMIS—Cristina reported that the committee is looking at policies and procedures to enhance the usefulness of HMIS related to coordinated entry and case conferencing. There will be a draft MOU which will be sent out to LCEH CE/CC Leads for making housing referrals form CE/CC meeting to housing providers. Once we have the MOUs and updated CE/HMIS policy information can be shared and the LCEH will be able to look at data in the county. Work is being done to update HMIS licensing fee/structure procedure with the goal of having an annual invoicing timeframe for renewing licenses. As policies are updated for CE, work will be done to align the CE and HMIS policy for making referrals, LCEHs to be able to look at county data. Meetings will be scheduled with the HMIS committee and Coordinated Entry committees. JEDI—The committee has drafted an equity statement that will be brought to the Governance Advisory Board for approval. The committee will be working on other issues across the CoC. Carole indicated that the considerations related to 1st time homeless and FMRs need to be taken into account related to PSH. As example the number of individuals experiencing homelessness for the 1st is rising, but they don't necessarily meet the definition of chronic homeless.
	David indicated that HUD has added eligible activities related to services in rural areas and resources for survivors of domestic violence which will be included in the bonus applications templates.
	Cristina asked about the partnerships needed related to health care, PHAs, and education. David indicated that discussions will be initiated in the next week or so—to see if there are possibilities for collaborations which meet HUD's criteria and where appropriate MOUs could be executed in alignment with the NOFO requirements.
	Lt. Governor Antone—asked about the Youth Homeless Demonstration Program and the opportunities. David indicated the information in the NOFO pertains to renewal of current YHDP projects. Currently the AZBOSCOC does not have YHDP but it is an opportunity that needs discussion during the year.
